Step 1

Please contact learning@uk-med.org to receive a unique code that will allow access the VLE. Please keep a record of this code, you will need this code for when you go to complete [Step 3](#).

Step 2

Register an online [RCSEd Online Account](#). This account will facilitate access to RCSEd's VLE.

Please take a note of your new College Reference Number. This can be found in the My Profile section of your RCSEd Online Account. You will need this reference number when you go to complete [Step 3](#).

Step 3

Please complete the [Course Enrolment Form](#). You will be asked to enter the unique code from UK-Med and your College Reference Number along with your preferred email address. We ask for your email address to send confirmation of your registration for this course.

Step 4

Please check your inbox (and junk folder) for a course registration confirmation email. Upon receipt of this confirmation email, you are now registered to access the VLE and can commence the course.

Please note: if you do not receive an email, or you receive notification that you do not have an account or the action has failed, then you must check that you have completed [Steps 1 and 2](#) and entered in the correct information for [Step 3](#). If the incorrect information has been entered for [Step 3](#), then you may receive an error message.

Step 5

You are now ready to access [the VLE](#). Please use the same log in details that were created to access the RCSEd Online Account.
